This requirement must be met with an official transcript submitted to the Office of Graduate Management Programs prior to registering for the first course(s). In addition, students must provide a personal statement explaining the motivation for their interest in WPI's graduate management program. Individuals taking courses prior to admission may have those courses applied to his or her program if formally accepted to a Graduate Management Program.
