Understandings

I understand that the MG Custom Program is intended to provide depth in a Humanities & Arts (beyond the Sufficiency), Social Science (beyond the MG Foundation), or business area. The area may be an existing academic discipline, such as History or Sociology or Marketing (for example, by using courses from other Consortium member schools), or it may be an area that cuts across several disciplines, such as Theatre Management and Marketing. Thus, the Custom Program should be a coherent and integrated package of courses.

I understand that, because this is a custom program, my official audit will reflect these courses. Any change to these courses must have prior approval from my academic advisor and the UPCC. Otherwise, I may not be permitted to graduate.

I understand that the Major Qualifying Project (MQP) must relate to my major as defined by the MG distribution requirements **and this custom program**. It is imperative that I complete an MQP deemed compatible with the distribution requirements **and this custom program**. Otherwise, I may not be permitted to graduate. Furthermore, it is my responsibility to find or develop such an MQP.
